



The Grapevine is committed to ensuring the health and safety of families and our community in the midst of the (COVID-19) pandemic. We ask that you partner with us in understanding how you and your child can help reduce the risk of transmission. We can do this together by staying current on the latest CDC and public health recommendations and taking common sense precautions. Below we have outlined measures we are taking to ensure your health and safety as well as a list of guidelines we ask you to follow prior to and during your attendance at programs. *We ask that you read this document carefully and agree by signing below.* If you don't understand or have questions about any part of this document, please talk to a Grapevine staff member. Please note this document is intended as general guidance and waiver and does not replace any program specific requirements.

Grapevine and Avenue A Facility Changes:

Programs:

- Fall 2020 Programs will be outdoor based
- Maintain a Social distance of a least 6 feet whenever possible
- Bring your own personal items such as chairs, coffee cups, water bottles, etc.
- When social distance is not possible outdoors, staff will wear a face mask. (Please refer to program specific information for participant mask requirements).

Sanitation & Health Precautions:

- Face Masks are required inside our buildings for anyone over the age of 2 years.
- On site, Hospital Grade HEPA air filter
- Fans to promote air circulation, open windows whenever possible
- Multiple stations with hand sanitizer including bathrooms
- Increased cleaning of bathrooms
- Frequent wipe down of door handles and other high-touch areas
- Disposable gloves and face masks available on site
- Doorbell will be installed at front door of Grapevine to control indoor traffic

Parent/Caregiver/Family Agreements & Responsibilities:

- When you and/or your child attend any Grapevine/Avenue A program, you understand there is an unavoidable risk that you and/or your child may become infected with COVID-19.
- If you, your child or a member of your household experiences any COVID-19 symptoms, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, nasal congestion, fatigue, fever, chills, muscle aches, headaches, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, and/or loss of taste or smell, that you and your child do not attend programs for at least 14 days and/or you are provided clearance by a medical professional that you or your child are not considered contagious. (Please let us know about any seasonal allergies that you or child may have).
- You agree to screen yourself and any family member prior to attending Grapevine/Avenue A programs based on the symptoms outlined above.
- In accordance with the State of NH COVID 19 travel requirements, if you and/or any family members travel outside of the New England states, upon return to NH, you must remain out of programs for 14 days. (These restrictions will be updated if state guidelines change).
- It is important that you understand that even with all of these precautions in place, as a result of attending Grapevine/Avenue A programs, you and/or your child may be exposed to COVID-19 and contract the disease; that your child may transmit the disease to others, including members of your household; and that as a result, your child and household members may experience COVID-19 symptoms, and may require isolation, quarantine and hospitalization.



In consideration for my/my child's enrollment in a Grapevine program(s)] I, (for myself and on behalf of my minor child), agree to forever release and discharge the Grapevine and its officers, employees, donors, and other agents and representatives (together, the "Released Parties") from, and agree not to sue for any and all liability or claims I (or my child) may have for any causes of action, liability, losses, or damages arising or resulting from property damage and loss, personal injury, emotional distress, illness, disability, or death, related to my/my child's attendance at the Grapevine during the COVID-19 pandemic. This release is for any type of claim, including breach of contract, negligence, fraud, or any other type of suit and includes losses alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Grapevine and the Released Parties, to the fullest extent permitted by law but does not include claims for intentional wrongdoing.
